The Airport has issued the following statement about the Master Plan:

The City of Palm Springs has initiated an Airport Master Plan to support future demand, continue safe and efficient operations, and to address changes in the aviation industry at the local level and the national level. This project will update outdated information in the existing Airport Master Plan and identify possible new projects to accommodate growth that will support the airport's long-term viability and enhance facility safety, while supporting economic development and the airport's commitment to be a good neighbor. The most recent Airport Master Plan for the Palm Springs International Airport (PSP) was completed in 2015.
